Open Enrollment begins **September 28, 2020** and ends **October 30, 2020**. There are no changes to the medical, dental or vision plan vendors; all medical plans have increased premiums. You are strongly encouraged to review the enclosed 2021 Retiree Summary for a thorough understanding of your benefits.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2021

- YOU ONLY NEED TO COMPLETE FORMS IF YOU ARE MAKING CHANGES. IF YOU TAKE NO ACTION, YOUR CURRENT COVERAGE WILL AUTOMATICALLY CONTINUE INTO 2021.
- Medical dental, and vision carriers are unchanged for 2021.
 - o Kaiser Permanente, Sutter Health Plus and Western Health Advantage continue to be available for non-Medicare coverage in both Traditional \$15 HMO co-pay plans and High Deductible HMO plans. The 2021 Non-Medicare Medical premiums start on Page 22 of the 2021 Retiree Summary.
 - Kaiser Permanente and UnitedHealthcare (UHC) continue to offer Medicare Advantage plans. The 2021 Medicare Medical premiums start on Page 26 of the 2021 Retiree Summary.
 - Deductible limits on the High Deductible Health plans remain the same and have not increased.
- If you wish to change medical plans, add or change dental or vision coverage, or add or drop dependents, you will need to complete the enclosed Retiree Open Enrollment Form.

Note: additional forms may be required when making changes to Kaiser Senior Advantage plans. Those forms are available on our website at http://www.personnel.saccounty.net/Benefits.

ALL PLANS (effective 1/1/2021)

• Enrollment forms for any changes you make are due in our office or post marked by October 30, 2020 by 5:00 PM. If you are adding a dependent to coverage you must bring (or submit) required documentation (described in the Retiree Summary) to the Employee Benefits Office by November 6, 2020 by 5:00 PM. Your dependents will not be enrolled without proper documentation.
