Q. Do I have to purchase a uniform?

The PC 832, Arrest, Search & Seizure and Firearms Familiarization Courses are designed to satisfy the requirement for Peace Officers, identified in Section 832 of the Penal Code as well as the minimum qualifications for the Sacramento Sheriff's Office, Sheriff's Security Officer position. Topics will include: Introduction to criminal law, laws of arrest, search & seizure, use of force, policing in the community, arrest and control, and firearms/chemical agents. Classes will require participants to engage in physically demanding training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.

Recruits must:

- Be 18 years or older
- Complete the Sacramento Sheriff's Office Pre-Employment Pre-Questionnaire (PEPQ)
- Have a DOJ Firearms Clearance Letter prior to Day One of Class. (If you plan to apply for the Sheriff's Security Officer position, the Sheriff's Office will pay for your Firearms Clearance.)

Frequently Asked Questions

- A. Recruit uniforms will not be required for the classroom instructions, but a T-shirt with Recruit's last name on the back will be needed for the range training as well as boots. The dress code will be discussed prior to Day One.
- Q. Will Firearms be provided for Training?
- A. Yes, firearms will be provided at training.
